Theatr Iolo is Wales leading theatre company for babies, children and young people. Theatr Iolo is an Arts Council Wales (ACW) Portfolio organisation and has a yearly income of between £325k and £450k, depending on the years activity. I am responsible for leading a bold artistic programme as well as overseeing the financial budget. I lead a team of 3 full time staff and over 40 freelancers and student placements.

Duties include: directing plays, commissioning and mentoring writers and artists, dramaturgical support, developing partnerships, negotiating co-productions, providing training opportunities, engaging with ACW, stakeholders, donors, and being a spokesperson for Theatr Iolo and the Theatre for Young Audiences (TYA) sector.

Theatr Iolo leads on TYA Cymru, This creative network develops and supports initiatives across Wales for work for young audiences.

I continue to direct plays outside of Wales in a freelance capacity.
